FROM OUR WEB EDITOR

It's some time since we promoted the DFWI (Dorset Federation of Women's Institutes) website and there are no doubt a few members who have not yet accessed it.

The website is part of a pyramid system with NFWI (National Federation of Women's Institutes) sitting at the top, where members are able to access just about any information they may wish to know about, from the roles of WI Committee Officers and Committee Members; the Constitution and Rules and the WI Handbook; Craft pages; MyWI; Campaign and Resolutions information and lots more.



The DFWI pages offer news, a calendar of events, booking forms for events, Glossary of Terms, and more. This is also where members and non-members are able to access information for each of the Dorset WIs. It may be that a non-member wishes to find out when a particular WI meets, or just read about what they do before they attend; a member may want to confirm something on their own WI programme for the year. It is the individual WIs who are responsible for "posting" their own pages to suit their individual needs.

Each month the DFWI pages are updated with new events, new booking forms, news items, etc and, in the case of an event sadly being cancelled, this will be posted on the website.

With technology being more and more the norm we would like to encourage as many members as possible to make use of the websites. A good example of how the DFWI website could benefit members is concerning events. There are occasions when WIs meet three, maybe four weeks, following a mailing. Events are generally posted on line as soon as they are confirmed and members accessing the website will often book immediately. By the time members hear about these events at their monthly meeting they may be too late to book a place

We must, however, remember that we continue to have members who, for various reasons, do not have access to the websites and must be catered for in either "buddying up" with another member or being kept up to date in other ways. We are not yet in a position where we can rely purely on technology so we also need to encourage WIs to explore their own way of including these members, be it helping them to learn how to have confidence on line, or making sure they are kept up to date with what is available to them to avoid them being disadvantaged.

Whether we like it or not technology is here to stay, and for those using it wisely, it can be a very positive tool.
